


#### SPECIAL REQUEST FROM BANK OF AMERICA

CONSIDER this observation by the reformer Martin Luther: "It is necessary to impress on people at large that all who would be called Christians owe it to God to consider those worthy of double honor who minister to their couls. How could you demonstrate this "double honor" to your own passess this week! (See also 1 Timothy 5:17.)
