
WE'VE MOVED!

UPDATE: COMPASSIONATE CARE FOR UKRAINIANS

Your Generosity Helps to Support Ukrainians In a Time of War

2022, has displaced millions of residents from their homes. The number of Ukrainians living as refugees in other countries has swelled into the millions. Meanwhile, the number of internallydisplaced Ukrainians—those who have fled their homes but remain in the country—is just as The ongoing invasion of Ukraine by a neighboring world power that began February 24, high. 

seven had sought shelter elsewhere the day their home was destroyed by rocket fire. With no Nyura* and her husband lived with their daughter and family in Chernihiv, Ukraine, when the house to return to, Nyura and her family crossed the border to Moldova. Many Ukrainian senior adults are being forced to make the difficult decision to stay home or leave; either choice holds war began. Early in the conflict, their city came under attack. Thankfully, the household of challenges for securing basic needs.

Nyura's family found food and shelter through the Nazarene church in Chisinau, led by Sergey and Irina Talalay. Church members have been transporting, sheltering, and feeding Ukrainians since the beginning of the conflict. The Chisinau church has also provided hygiene items and medicine when possible. Sergey, also from Ukraine, tells about the positive impact the church has had on thousands of displaced Ukrainians. "I am very

grateful to our local church," says Sergey. "Although it is small, it has a very big heart."
