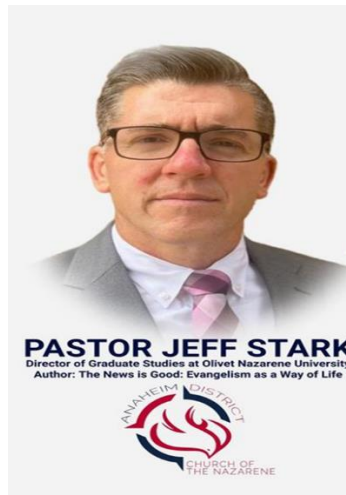

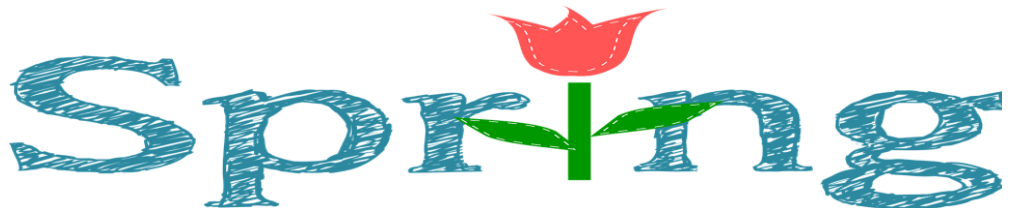

Our NMI is joining efforts with our District to collect and complete Crisis Care Kits to be used around the world (and here in the US). Below is a list of items you may help us to collect each month for this cause. We found that by collecting single items, we can contribute more complete kits. Perhaps you too can help.....

CRISIS CARE KITS

Schedule of Collection:
Each month a separate item will be emphasized to collect so that we can spread out the costs for each individual kit and collect and compile more cases for donation and distribution. Last time we collected 7 cases (42 kits).

FEBRUARY – 1 sturdy comb per kit

MARCH – 1 Beanie Baby sized stuffed toy per kit

APRIL – 1 nail clipper per kit

MAY – 4 individual travel size packs of tissue per kit

JUNE – 2 hand towels per kit

JULY – 2 bath size bars of soap
Per kit (no travel size)

AUGUST – 1 box of Band-Aids per kit
(minimum 30 count)

SEPTEMBER – 1 shampoo per kit
(12 to 16 oz. size)

OCTOBER – 1 box of toothpaste
(4 to 6.4 oz. size) per kit

Dear Praying Friends at La Mirada Church of the Nazarene, South East Asia Encounter 3. That's the name of my team of 9 CBU college students that I will lead this summer for an International Service Project (ISP), or a.k.a., short-term mission team, to South East Asia. Because the country is predominantly Muslim, we are asked to identify the region, but not the specific country, primarily for the safety of our field partners that we will work beside.

One of my roles with Wycliffe/JAARS carries the title "JAARS Campus Ambassador" to California Baptist University's Aviation Sciences program. The objective is to expand awareness and cast vision for missionary aviation service among CBU's 200+ aviation students and staff flight instructors.

Thus I was asked to lead an Aviation focused ISP Team to one of the JAARS aviation programs operating overseas. April 25-May 15 - the 3-week event is the capstone of a semester long journey of discipleship, training, team-building and preparation that our team is presently undertaking.

The purpose of this letter is to invite you as one of our partnering churches to involve your congregation in praying for this ISP program and event. Specifically, please pray for our team's provision, safety, effectiveness in ministry, and for the personal and spiritual growth of each team member as we encounter what will most surely be a life-changing experience. And pray for those to whom we will minister, that our service will glorify God by encouraging the missionaries with whom we will work and through our witness and testimony, the Gospel of Jesus will penetrate hearts of some who do not yet believe.

Thank you so much for considering this. We cherish your prayers. We know the importance of praying and that where believers are striving to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus, spiritual warfare is surely to be waged. Please pray with and for us.
